DYNAMIC HURDLES – Novice Only: 10 -16 obstacles consisting of jumps and 1-2 tunnels. Obstacles can be used more than once.

Beginner Agility - A will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC Beginner title and other restrictions as set forth by UKC rules as of January 1, 2011.

Intermediate Agility A will be open to dogs that have not earned a UKC Intermediate title and other restrictions as set forth by UKC rules as of January 1, 2011

**All Contacts and Table are rubberized non-slip surface. Floor is textured agility matting.**

**HURDLE HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

Division Toy (4") – Dogs up to and including 10" at the withers  
Division 1 (8") – Dogs over 10" & up to & including 14" at withers.  
Division 2 (14") – Dogs over 14" & up to & including 20" at withers.  
Division 3 (20") – Dogs over 20" at withers.

ALL DOGS (except toy) ARE ELIGIBLE TO JUMP MINIMUM HEIGHT (4" lower than regular height)

Ribbons will be presented to top four placements in each Division  
Prizes will be presented to 1st thru 4th in each Division with a limit of 2 toys per dog for the weekend.

### **Richard Stanfield Memorial Trophy**

Plaque presented to the dog with the highest combined score in Beginner, Intermediate & Excellent in a single trial during the weekend. Dog must have an UACHX or higher to qualify.

### **MOVE UPS**

Dogs finishing a title on Friday or Saturday may move up to the next higher class for Saturday or Sunday. Move up forms are available at the trial.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

There will be individual familiarization walk through on lead before each class only for dogs entered in Beginner A, Intermediate A and for Beginner-B and Intermediate-B dogs which have not earned the Beginner or Intermediate titles respectively and are not eligible to run in the A class. Dogs must wear a flat buckle collar attached to a leash for the familiarization walk.

Dogs may run with or without a collar. Slip collars, prong collars, or collars with tags are prohibited. Scored performances must be done off lead. If there are obstacles for which you have not trained, bypass them for safety's sake. To receive a qualifying score, dog and handler team must successfully complete all obstacles.

A dog may be entered in Beginner and Intermediate classes at the same agility trial. However, titles will be awarded by UKC in sequence. If a dog meets all requirements for the Intermediate title, they must complete the Beginner title before the certificates or dog's record is updated by UKC.

No entry fees will be refunded after closing date unless entries can be replaced with wait list entries.

Bitches in season may not compete. A full refund will be made if notified prior to the start of the trial.

Dogs must be under handler's control at all times.

Ample crating space is available. Please bring a mat to put under your crates. Exhibitor crates may be left in the building overnight. No dogs may be left overnight.

Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs excused due to aggression.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme &/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency or any cause beyond the control of Companion Dog Club of Tulsa or the show committee.

**NOTE: No dogs under 8 weeks of age are allowed on trial site premises.**
