**Show Hours**

Building opens at noon on Friday and at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday & Sunday

Pre-entries will be accepted on a "first received" basis beginning Friday, July 14, 2023. No entries accepted prior to this date. Pre-entries will close Friday, August 25, 2023. Day of Show entries on Friday will be taken from 12:00 - 12:30 p.m. Trial 1 starts at 1:00 p.m. Handler Discrimination will run back to back beginning with Novice followed by Trial 2 Novice. Day of Show entries for Saturday and Sunday will be taken from 7:15 – 7:45 a.m. Judging will begin at 8:00 a.m. for Trial 1 Elite Exterior and Trial 1 Novice Containers will begin at 8:15 a.m. Trial 2 will follow Trial 1 starting with Novice Interior and Novice Containers. Move-ups will be permitted.

**Pre-Entry fees:** \$20.00 for each element entered (Jr. Handler \$10).

**Day of Show Entry fees:** \$25 for each element entered (Jr. Handler \$15).

A fee of \$25.00 will be levied for a returned check. All entries must be submitted on Official UKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and will not be entered in the trial. FAX'd entries and/or credit card payments cannot be accepted. Entries sent by overnight mail must not require a signature. Entry cancellations will be accepted up until August 25 and full refund of entries made. Changes must be made to the Secretary by email or in writing. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the show committee or UKC. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial with a veterinarian's certificate prior to the start of the trial.

### **Trial Information - Exhibitors**

Novice title is required to enter the Advanced level. Advanced title is required to enter the Superior level.

Superior title is required to enter the Master level. Master title is required to enter the Elite level.

The “A Division” of an element is open to any handler that has not earned a Nosework title in any organization or earned their title in that level of the element being entered and their handler is not a Nosework judge or Nosework instructor.

Handlers are only allowed to run 1 dog per level in individual elements.

At the discretion of the judge, trial volunteers may run their dogs before other exhibitors as needed.

**A UKC REGISTRATION NUMBER IS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN LICENSED TRIALS.**
